We are delighted to welcome you and your children to a new academic session at our school. As you know, we offer a variety of extracurricular activities (ECA) to enrich the learning experience of our students and foster their physical, social, and emotional development. In this newsletter, we would like to inform you about some of the ECA activities that will be taking place in the first term.

One of the most popular ECA activities at our school is swimming. Swimming is a great way to improve fitness, coordination, and confidence in the water. We have a team of qualified instructors who will teach your children the basic skills and techniques of swimming, as well as water safety and hygiene. Swimming sessions are going on as per the schedule provided. Please make sure your children bring their swimsuits, towels and goggles and other essentials during their scheduled day.

Another ECA activity that we are offering this term is house division. House division is a system that divides the students into four houses: Red (Laligurans), Blue (Saptakoshi), Green (Manaslu), and Yellow (Tilicho). Each house has a teacher leader and a student captain who will organize and motivate their members to participate in various competitions and events throughout the year. House division aims to promote teamwork, leadership, and school spirit among the students.

Finally, we are proud to announce that we have partnered with a Nepal Taekwondo Association to offer Taekwondo classes as an ECA activity. Taekwondo is a martial art that teaches self-defense, discipline, and respect. It also helps to improve strength, flexibility, and balance. Our Taekwondo instructor will teach your children the basic moves and forms of Taekwondo, as well as the values and etiquette of the sport. Taekwondo classes are held only for the students of grade VI to X as a club activity. This month we are organizing belt test exams at school for those students who have participated in Taekwondo classes last year. The further details of the program will be sent soon.
