Dear Parents, Guardians, and Well-wishers, Namaste!

We sincerely extend our heartfelt gratitude to all parents, guardians, teachers, and students for your continuous support and constructive feedback in enriching our Extracurricular Activities (ECA) programmes. Your active participation and encouragement have played a pivotal role in motivating our students to explore, compete, and shine beyond the classroom walls.

- This term marks the starting of our **Swimming Classes**, running from **Baishakh 24 to Asar 12**. Due to unpredictable weather conditions, we were unable to complete the swimming sessions as scheduled. However, the postponed swimming sessions have been rescheduled for all grades. These sessions have helped students build confidence in the water, improve their swimming skills and techniques, and understand the basics of swimming and water safety. After completing the swimming sessions, we will organize a grade-wise swimming competition to conclude the swimming program.
- Our Music/Dance instructors and Arts and Craft teachers are working collaboratively to make different events and celebrations successful. They have played vital role in 'Eat your vegetables day' celebration of Grade-3.
